Taylor praises measure to outlaw synthetic marijuana

Drug Causes Dangerous Side Effects in Users

Legislation backed by State Rep. John Taylor to outlaw K-2 and other synthetic marijuana overwhelmingly passed the Pennsylvania House last week and now moves to the state Senate for consideration.

"This is yet another major step toward removing dangerous drugs off our streets," Taylor said. Synthetic marijuana, also known by its more common brand "K-2," is a blend of herbs treated with chemicals to produce a marijuana-like high in users.

"Synthetic marijuana poses a direct threat to our neighborhoods and our children because it is perceived to be safe since it is not classified as a

controlled substance," Taylor said. "This legislation will now ban all forms of synthetic marijuana in Pennsylvania, and establishes penalties for those who break the law by using or selling this drug."

Synthetic marijuana causes many dangerous side effects, and because it is not a controlled substance, it can be found in so-called "head shops" and on the internet under the names "Demon" and "Hawaiian Haze."

Emergency rooms throughout Pennsylvania have seen an increase in visits from people suffering illnesses from the drug, including rapid heart rates, confusion, nausea, agitation, anxiety, elevated blood

pressure, hallucinations, and seizures. It has also been linked to deaths throughout the country. Different mixes of synthetic marijuana sold on the street contain various dangerous chemicals that pose real health risks to users.
